Today, Sunday 19th February, we gather for our **Annual Meeting**. This is in part a business meeting at which reports are received, financial accounts noted, and appointments made. It is also, and more importantly, a time for us to come together as a church community, review our life under God, and respond to the vision that God is calling us to embrace. Churches are a curious mixture of business and community, and the two aspects need to be held in a kind of creative tension. Because we are dealing with money, employees, and because we exist in a regulated world, we have a duty of care to ensure we do things 'right'. Alongside that we place our calling to be a community of faith, concerned with the Kingdom of God and often being a countersign to the ways of the world. In many ways this tension we

experience as a church is the same as the tension we can feel in our personal lives. I am a Christian, I believe passionately in the way of Jesus Christ and the life to which he calls us. But I live in a society which, for the wellbeing (hopefully) of all people is structured in a certain way. I am called to be 'in the world but not of it'. What holds us together as a faith community, the people of Christ, is not a shared label, nor even a common understanding of the Gospel (I wish!). It is a demanding common task to which God calls each and everyone of us. And in the pursuit of that common task we discover what matters, and what doesn't matter nearly as much as we once thought. So, how do we at TAM frame our demanding common task?

LAST SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY

2 Kings 2.1-12; Psalm 50.1-6;
2 Corinthians 4.3-12; Mark 9.2-9

In images of the Transfiguration, while God the Father is speaking to Jesus in the presence of Moses and Elijah, Jesus Christ stands with his feet on the earth, next to Peter, James and John. For many people, the Transfiguration shows the place where human nature and the temporal meet God the eternal. Yet, the place is not as important as the person who was both fully God and fully man, who bridges the gap between heaven

and earth. Let us put our faith in Jesus who was tempted in every way, but did not sin.

- Pray for those who are looking for a sign or a miracle; that God would answer their prayers in natural and supernatural ways.
- Give thanks for the opportunity to deepen your spiritual life this coming Lent by attending a Lenten Study, reading spiritual books, or by praying more regularly.
